I am also winner of Swiss Excellence Scholarship 2014-2015. Currently, I teaching at the Department of Sociology, Quaid-i-Azam University Islamabad. I am author of two books: Exchange Marriages in South Punjab, Pakistan: A Sociological Analysis of Kinship Structure, Agency, and Symbolic Culture and Youth Politics in Pakistan: Civic Engagement and Opportunity Structure (in press). Beside this, I published 30 research articles in international peer review journals (including impact factor journal). My areas of interests are interdisciplinary including sociology of family youth, childhood, family and marriage. I also presented my research work in 20 national and international conferences in different parts of the world. I worked as Researcher and Teacher at the University of Leipzig, Germany from 2005 to 2011. Previously, I worked for the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) Pakistan as a Project Officer. I produced concept papers, managed projects on nature conservations and developed policy papers. I won the funding from the Higher Education Commission (HEC) of Pakistan a number of other local funding. Beside this, I am commentator on social issues at various TV channels (including PTV, Roze TV, Roayl TV, Hum News, Capital TV and Such TV in Pakistan). I was listed among the top 2% scientists list of the Plos Biology Journal and only sociologist from Pakistan in 2020.
